The Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority (VCAA) has determined that Structured Workplace Learning (SWL) is a valuable component of all VET Delivered to Secondary School students (VDSS) qualifications undertaken. VCAA strongly recommends that students undertake a minimum of 80 hours of SWL over the duration of the VDSS Certificate III in Makeup.
