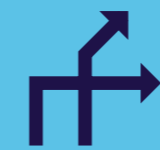

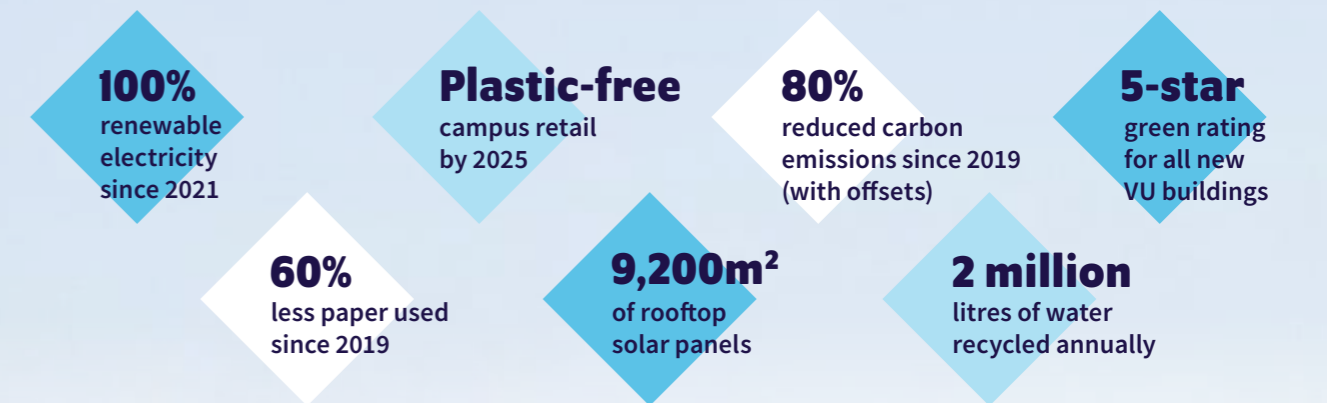

What is credit?

Most subjects (units) equal 12 credit points. If you're studying full time, you'll generally complete a total of 8 subjects per year – that's four subjects in semester one and four subjects in semester two.

For pathways that grant credits: 48 credit points is equivalent to 4 subjects or one semester of study (6 months), 96 credit points is equivalent to 8 subjects or two semesters of study (one year) and 144 credit points is equivalent to 12 subjects or three semesters of study (one and a half years).

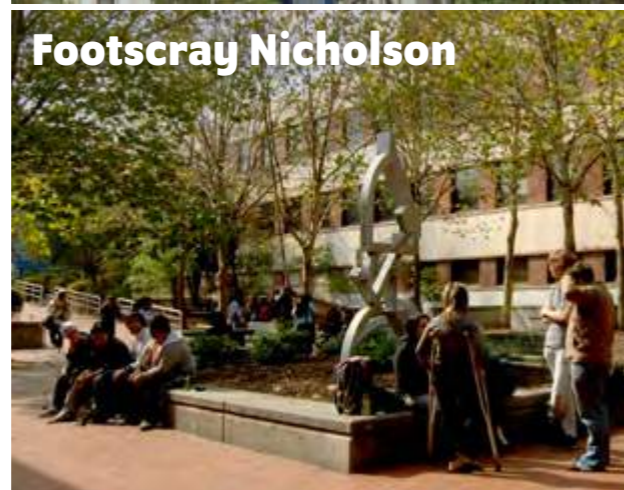

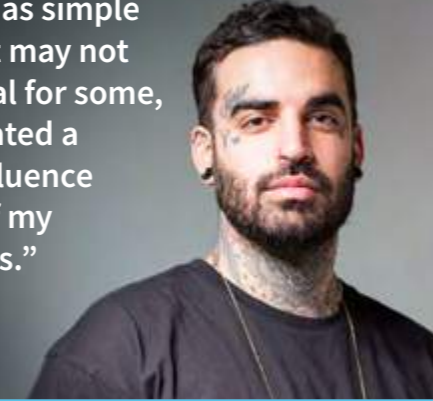
