Students are required to pass the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education (LANTITE) in order to be eligible to graduate from their Victorian Institute of Teaching-
	accredited program. These tests need to be successfully completed before moving into the 2 nd year of the program. *Please not teaching practicum must be completed in the designated block period.
