Recommended Sequence for Placement

Here is a sequence you may wish to follow to successfully complete your placements and units.

- Placement Block 1 (10 consecutive days): To be completed after successful completion of your first unit and before the successful completion of your 4th unit.
- Placement Block 2 (10 consecutive days): To be completed once you have completed Placement Block 1 and before successful completion of your 7th unit.
- Placement Block 3 (10 consecutive days): To be completed once you have completed Placement Block 2 and before the completion of your 9th unit.
- Placement Block 4 (10 consecutive days): To be completed once you have completed Placement Block 3 and before the completion of your 12th unit.
- Placement Block 5 (20 consecutive days) To be completed during your final unit EED7004 in any Study Period from 2 to 6, except Study Period 1 of any given year due to summer school holiday closures.

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
