Course Requirements	To attain the award of Master of Teaching (Secondary Education), students must successfully complete 192 credit points (equivalent to 14 units), consisting of: Twelve x 12 credit point units equivalent to 144 credit points and two x 24 credit point units equivalent to 48 credit points. Students must complete 60 days practical school placement. Please refer to the 'Essentials Guide' that will be sent to students via the University's Project Partnership Office for full information about placements.

Literacy and Numeracy Test	Students commencing a Victoria University Initial Teacher Education Program after July 1, 2016, are required to pass the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students (LANTITE) to be eligible to graduate from their Victorian Institute of Teaching-accredited program. Students are required to meet the benchmark for the LANTITE before they commence their 9 th unit of study. Students will need to monitor the VIT website for details in relation to the tests that will be considered; a link to advice and fact sheets about the test and to the external test provider. Recommended Sequence for Placement

Here is a sequence you *may* wish to follow to successfully complete your placements and units.

- **Placement Block 1 (10 consecutive days):**
To be completed after successful completion of your first unit and before the successful completion of your 4th unit.
- **Placement Block 2 (10 consecutive days):**
To be completed once you have completed Placement Block 1 and before successful completion of your 7th unit.
- **Placement Block 3 (10 consecutive days):**
To be completed once you have completed Placement Block 2 and before the completion of your 9th unit.
- **Placement Block 4 (10 consecutive days):**
To be completed once you have completed Placement Block 3 and before the completion of your 12th unit.
- **Placement Block 5 (20 consecutive days)**
To be completed during your final unit EED7004 in any Study Period from 2 to 6, except Study Period 1 of any given year due to summer school holiday closures.

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
