<b>Course Requirements</b>	<p>To attain the award of Master of Teaching (Secondary Education), students must successfully complete 192 credit points (equivalent to 14 units), consisting of:</p> <p>Twelve x 12 credit point units equivalent to 144 credit points and two x 24 credit point units equivalent to 48 credit points. Students must complete 60 days practical placement. Please refer to 'The Essentials', which will be sent to students via the University's Partnership Placement team for full information about Placements.</p> <p><b>Please note: placement cannot take place in Study Period 1 as schools are closed. This means EED7004 cannot be taken in Study Period 1 of any year.</b></p>

<b>Literacy and Numeracy Test</b>	<p>Students are required to pass the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education (LANTITE) within the <b>first year of their course</b> to be eligible to graduate from their Victorian Institute of Teaching-accredited program. Students are required to achieve LANTITE before entering second year. Students will need to monitor the VIT website for details in relation to the tests that will be considered; a link to advice and fact sheets about the test and to the external test provider. ### Recommended Sequence for Placement

Here is a sequence you *may* wish to follow to complete successfully your placements and units.

- **Placement Block 1 (10 consecutive days):**  
To be completed after successful completion of your first unit and before the successful completion of your 4th unit.
- **Placement Block 2 (10 consecutive days):**  
To be completed once you have completed Placement Block 1 and before successful completion of your 7th unit.
- **Placement Block 3 and 4 (X 2 10 consecutive days):**  
To be completed once you have completed Placement Block 2 and before the completion of your 12th unit.
- **Placement Block 5 (20 consecutive days)**  
To be completed during your final unit EED7004 in any Study Period except Study Period 1 of any given year due to School Holidays.

Note: Placement Block 5 is embedding in EED7004 (20 days placement). Placement Block 5 must be completed during the running of this unit, as the Assessment for Graduate Teaching (AfGT) project is based on your placement.

You must experience placement in two different schools. If you have two specialisations, your first 30 days of placement (Placement Blocks 1, 2 and 3), would be undertaken in one specialisation, and your second 30 days of placement (Placement Blocks 4 and 5), would be undertaken in your second specialisation.
