Course Requirements	<p>To attain the award of Master of Primary Teaching, students must successfully complete 192 credit points (equivalent to 14 units) in total, consisting of:</p> <p>Twelve x 12 credit point units equivalent to 144 credit points and two x 24 credit point units equivalent to 48 credit points, equal to a total of 192 course credit points.</p> <p>Students must also complete a minimum of 65 days practical placement as part of the qualification.</p> <p>Please note: placement cannot take place in Study Period 1 as schools are closed. This means EED7005 and EED7004 cannot be taken in Study Period 1 of any year.</p>

LANTITE is a prerequisite for EED5102, ETP5002, ETP5003, and EED7004.</p> <p>Students will need to monitor the VIT website for details in relation to the tests that will be considered, a link to advice and fact sheets about the test and to the external test provider.
