Literacy and Numeracy Test	Students are required to pass the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education (LANTITE) within the <b>first year of their course</b> to be eligible to graduate from their Victorian Institute of Teaching accredited program. LANTITE is a prerequisite for EED5102, ETP5002, ETP5003, and EED7004. Students will need to monitor the VIT website for details in relation to the tests that will be considered, a link to advice and fact sheets about the test and to the external test provider.
