#### **Welcome to Footscray Park Campus!**

This is a sensory map created to help you find your way around Footscray Park Campus.

It can help you understand the sensory environments and assist you with accessible wayfinding.



These maps highlight low, medium, and high sensory environments.

They note the expected smells, sights, loud noise, and crowded areas.

It can also help you identify any quieter areas and sensory friendly spaces on campus.

Everyone's sensory experiences on campus can be different, and campus life can change day-to-day depending on events/pop-ups/class times and crowds.

#### Reading The Sensory Maps and Wayfinding Tips:

Footscray Park Campus is built on a steep hill, and because of this, entry levels to buildings can vary between each building.

You may notice some buildings not mapped on every level, and wayfinding guidance goes into a building on one level, and out on another (this indicates the need for lift to navigate to the entry/exit points).

White areas indicate staff office spaces or classrooms.

#### In general:

- Level 1 is considered the "ground floor" for buildings M, P, L, E and G and
- Level 2 is considered the "ground floor" for Buildings D, C, A and K
- Grey indicates an area currently under construction.












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
