| COURSE REQUIREMENTS | <p>To attain the Bachelor of Laws (Graduate Entry) students will be required to complete 288 credit points consisting of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 228 credit points of Core Law studies• 60 credit points of Law Elective studies. <p>To be awarded a Bachelor of Laws (Honours) (For students enrolled post 1 January 2015):</p> <p>Students in any Bachelor of Laws course may apply to transfer into any Bachelor of Laws (Honours) course if the selection criteria is met. Students who enrolled post 2015 in any Bachelor of Laws may apply to transfer into the Bachelor of Laws (Honours) degree once they have completed a minimum 192 credit points and have attained an average mark of Distinction or above i.e. 70–100%. Applicants will be assessed on the highest grades achieved in the top 12 Law units. Students will be further assessed on an outline of a proposed thesis topic and availability of a college based or college affiliated supervisor. Successful applicants will enrol in both Advanced Research Legal Methods and Advanced Legal Research Dissertation instead of 24 credit points of law electives.</p> |
