<b>COURSE REQUIREMENTS</b>	<p>To attain the Master of Teaching (Secondary Education) students will be required to complete 192 credit points in total consisting of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 168 Credit points of Core studies;</li><li>• 24 credit points of Capstone Studies;</li><li>• EED7004 Engaging the Profession can only be taken at the end of the course.</li><li>• Students must successfully complete 60 practicum days in a secondary school.</li></ul> <p>Students are required to pass the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education (LANTITE) in order to be eligible to graduate from their Victorian Institute of Teaching-accredited program. There is a course imperative that all students sign up for and undertake the first LANTITE window, and will have VU support with this. This is to enable them to progress through the course and be prepared for their PTT phase.</p>
