1. Enrolment

It is important you organize a time to meet with your principal supervisor to establish agreed timelines for meetings throughout your candidature and to gain a mutual understanding of your roles.

2. Coursework Units

Coursework units provide early support to candidates in the crucial pre-confirmation of candidature phase and are an important foundation for networking with fellow candidates and wider research staff.

To progress to the research phase, you must successfully complete with an average mark of 70% or above across the relevant units and 70% in your Year One Thesis.

3. Confirmation of Candidature

1st candidature milestone - oral presentation Undertaken within 15 months EFT of your enrolment- *meet with your supervisor to discuss your proposal.* You must obtain candidature approval to become an 'official' candidate in your course. **HDR Researcher Integrity modules** 1, 3, 4 and 10/11 before CoC. **HDR Researcher Integrity modules** 2, 5, 9 and 12 by the middle of your degree.

4. Towards Submission

2nd candidature milestone- oral presentation.

Undertaken within 3 years EFT of your enrolment and after successful completion of Confirmation of Candidature- meet with your supervisor to discuss your milestone application.

5. Thesis Submission

Timely submission of thesis- 4 years EFT of your enrolmentprior to submission, meet with your supervisor to discuss your thesis and potential examiners.

You must include the <u>Student Declaration</u> & declaration regarding Ethics Approval in your thesis.

6. Classification

Once your thesis has been examined, you must make the required changes and apply for classification.

Once your thesis is classified, the Dean Graduate Research will recommend to a University Council meeting that your award be conferred.

Following conferral, you may use the title 'Dr'. Useful links:

Once you have been conferred by University Council and lodged an electronic copy of your thesis and VURR form, you will receive a 'Notification of Completion.'

You will then be eligible to attend the next graduation ceremony.
