### STUDENT SAFETY FLOWCHART

A situation where a student presents as distressed or at risk, and where there is a likelihood of self-harm or harm to others

### **Examples:**

- Involvement in a traumatic event
- Distressed

## Distressed student, including exposure to trauma

#### **Actions:**

- 1. Speak with the student and determine what the student is concerned about
- 2. Consider what supports/assistance you may be able to provide, e.g. extensions for assignment
- 3. Consider student support services that may be appropriate, e.g. Counselling, Advocacy, Disability, Safer Community
- 4. Make a future appointment with student to follow up on how they are doing
- 5. Consult with professional staff at the university to make a referral, e.g. Student Counselling

- Suicidal
- Self-harm

# Self-harm risk or suicidal student

#### **Actions:**

- 1. Assess risk
- 2. Ensure safety. If risk is acute contact emergency services on 000.
- 3. If risk is not acute;
  During business hours consult with Manager,
  Counselling & Accessibility Services (9919 5400)
